World Wildlife Fund (WWF) is a world-leading conservation organisation working across 100 countries. Formed in 1961, the organisation aims to conserve nature and reduce the threats to the diversity of life on earth.

The library

The <u>WWF UK branch</u> has a library that is used by staff, researchers and occasional students for research purposes. With a collection of books, journals and an off-site archive of <u>WWF</u> publications the library offers a central hub of specialist information on conservation and wildlife. <u>WWF</u> chose <u>Liberty</u> as their library management system to offer a central management and search system, enabling users across all three UK <u>WWF</u> sites to access the library. Allison Jackson, <u>WWF</u> Librarian comments:

Using Liberty

The <u>WWF</u> base in the UK have access to an off-site archive of approximately 4,000 <u>WWF</u> publications and collections, these records can be searched within the <u>Liberty</u> catalogue to be requested to read, extending the access to sharing of information across the organisation globally.

Approximately 1,000 printed books along with journals and online articles are all catalogued in Liberty, the intuitive and advanced searching functionality makes it easy for library users to find exactly what they need for their research. The management functionality is intuitive supporting the efficient management of the library with automatic workflows for cataloguing and circulation among more. Allison further comments:

"Liberty is an easy-to-use system, there is clear navigation and it's reliable in every way – making my job much easier. I particularly like the cataloguing functionality, as a long-term user of Liberty I can say it's a great resource management solution"

Users can also access the library via the <u>WWF</u> intranet, this is achievable through a web API that enables integration between <u>Liberty</u> and intranet sites.

The library catalogue can be searched directly from the intranet, making online articles and resources more accessible internally and from any remote location.
